Phases

160kms ER 3*

There will be six phases:

- Phase 1 30kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 2 30kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 3 30kms into a VG of 50 minutes
- Phase 4 30kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 5 20kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 6 20kms into finish (vetting within 30 minutes of finishing)

120kms ER 2*

- Phase 1 30kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 2 30kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 3 20kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 4 20kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 5 20kms into finish (vetting within 30 minutes of finishing)

90kms ER*

- Phase 1 30kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 2 30kms into a VG of 40 minutes
- Phase 3 30kms into finish (vetting within 30 minutes of finishing)

80kms ER

There will be three phases:

- Phase 1 30kms into a VG of 40 minutes hold
- Phase 2 30kms into a VG of 30 minutes hold
- Phase 3 20kms into finish (vetting within 30 minutes of finishing)

CR's

- 80kms 30kms loop + 30kms loop + 20kms loop
- 64kms 34kms + 30kms loop
- 50 kms 30kms loop + 20kms loop
- 40 kms 40kms – see the order of Cps on map
- 30 kms 30kms loop
- 20 kms 20kms loop

The 30 kms loop is marked on the map in Orange and the 20kms loop in black

On the ground there will be orange coloured spray paint for all the routes.

Initial vetting for the 160kms classes will begin at 16.00 on the 10th April

Vetting for the other ER classes will be on the morning of the ride: 120kms between 5.45am and 6.15am, 90kms and 80kms ER's approx 1 hour before their start.

Start times for the classes on Saturday are as follows

- Class 1 160 kms FEI 3* 5.30am
- Class 2 120kms FEI 2* 7.00am
- Class 3 120kms FEI/J/YR 2* 7.15am
- Class 4 90kms FEI 1* 8.00am
- Class 5 90kms FEI/J/YR 1* 9.00am
- Class 7 80kms ER 9.15am
- Class 4 80kms CR between 9.20am and 9.30am
- Class 5 64kms CR between 9.20am and 9.30am

**Sunday start times will be approx 30 minutes after vet time. First horses away around 9.00 am
Please present to the vet between the following times:**

Classes 13 + 14	8.30am – 9.00am
Classes 16,17 + 18	9.00am – 9.30 am
Classes 19,20 + 21	9.30am – 10.00am

All NCR classes between 10.00am + 11.00am

Pulse rates for FEI/ER/CR and 64CR

At each **vet gate** a pulse check will be taken, 64 or below in **20** minutes

At **final vetting** a pulse check will be taken, 64 or below in **30** minutes

The 80CR will have 2 vet gates into holds of 30mins.

The 64CR will have 1 vet gate into a hold of 30mins

This may change on the day – please check with Secretary.

Crewing

Please use the designated crew spots. These are the safest. Please crew sensibly. If your crew are seen crewing anywhere they shouldn't you may be eliminated so make sure you brief your crew accordingly.

Riders are responsible for their crew at all times during the ride.

Facilities at the venue:

Toilets, refreshments, water, first aid and a farrier are available. The route will be marked clearly in paint arrows on the ground. The route will be stewarded by the TRF and REVCOMM. There are no gates on the ride and minimal roadwork. The route follows forest tracks and bridleways. The route also follows ancient routeways through the Royal estates that make up the Dukeries, Thoresby, Clumber and Welbeck. There is no detailed talk round for this route.

Coralling and camping:

There is coralling and camping available at the venue from Friday only (if you need to arrive earlier please contact the Organiser). There will be no facilities before this date. Please pay the secretary on arrival if you have not done so with your entry. The cost is £15 per horse to coral for the duration of the event. Make sure that your coral is electrified at all times, you may be asked to leave the venue if this is not complied with. Camping is free. Please note where tents need to be erected. This is because of Health and Safety. Lorries and caravans can be parked next to corals. (Please see venue plan – if you are in the wrong place you may be asked to move!)

All reasonable precautions have been taken by the Ride Organisation to ensure the health and safety of competitors. A copy of the risk assessment is available at the venue.

Remember a lot of people have given their time freely so you can have a nice day so do smile at them and say thank you!

Directions to Venue:

From M1 Southbound – J30. Follow A616 through Clowne, Cresswell and Cuckney to junction with B6034. At mini roundabout turn left then immediately right on to Thoresby Park road. Venue is past the hotel and the entrance to the Park but further on and on the Events field – signposted.

From M1 Northbound– As above or J28 and follow A38 to Mansfield then the A60 to towards Worksop at Cuckney take the A616. Please note the M1 northbound on Friday afternoon can be a nightmare!

From A1 Southbound and A1 Northbound – follow A1 to roundabout with A614. Take A614 south and follow to right turn signposted Thoresby Park.

Haywood Oaks Crewing Information

All riders need to make sure they give this sheet to their crews!

Main crew points

From the venue turn left out on to Park Road. At mini roundabout turn right. Up the hill to

Duncan Wood

Road crossing B6034. Please do not park on the road or block the access on either side of the road.

Please drive in to the car park to the east of the road, park up carefully, then crew.

From Duncan Wood turn left and follow back to mini roundabout, go straight, at second mini roundabout turn right then immediately left. Follow to horses crossing sign and turn left. Crew anywhere along this track. This is

Holborn Hill Plantation.

Be careful as horses are also using this track. Do not park on the arrows marking the horse route.

Leave crew point and return to main road, turn right and follow to T junction with A616. Turn right to min roundabout, stay on A616 through Budby village. Pass road crossing signs for horses – do not crew here – look for right turn to Edwinstowe, pass this turning staying on A616, then turn immediately left on tarmac drive. This is Ceres Lodge drive and

Ceres Lodge

Please drive up the tarmac road but not further than the electric gate. Horses cross this track. Please park carefully.

Leave Ceres Lodge and back to A616. Turn left and follow to roundabout, turn left onto A614. A few hundred yards turn left into huge layby. Metal gates on left lead to Proteus Camp. You will have to park and walk.

Proteus camp entrance

You can park in the entrance to this but you will have to walk to where the horses cross the track.

Leave laybe and turn left on to A614. Follow to roundabout and sign to Thoresby Park and hotel. Venue on left.

No crews at Hazel Gap on the A616 or south of Budby village

All crew points will be marked onto the main map at the venue, please check on arrival that there have been no changes to this.

Please be aware if you are trying to crew on Sunday there is a very busy Sunday market very close to the venue. If you go out and crew there is no guarantee you will be able to get back to the venue!
